LGS 29 Milverton Section Update 30 Oct 2016

Grid Ref: SP30096640

Brief Description:

This site is a partially quarried river bank section on a public right of way. This site reveals a composite section through more than 3m of Triassic, Sherwood Sandstone Group, Bromsgrove Sandstone Formation strata.

Monitoring Report

The site is on the banks of the Avon and is slightly prone to littering but otherwise is a good site albeit one of 5 Bromsgrove Sandstone LGS sites (30, 43, 81 and 99) which the group oversees.



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Status: The site is as above - quite a bit of ivy, but no worse than in 2008. No change.

Access/Parking for cars: about 14-16 cars can be parked in adjacent streets, i.e. St James Meadow Rd.....or it can be accessed (with permission) from Rock Mill La.
