Location

The exposure is on the northern bank of the ditch surrounding the Biffa Landfill site and is located approximately halfway along the most northerly ditch, adjacent to the outer perimeter of the site.

Summary of Interest

The ditches expose about 1m of Langport Member limestone above c. 2m of green-grey silty clay of the Cotham Member. Special interest is provided by a seam of encrusting bivalves at the junction of the two units and various fossils and trace fossils in the overlying limestone.
