Location

The road location is on the B4116 550m SW of the junction with the A5. The site is on the SE side of the road. The quarry is accessed via the lodge at the entrance to the Merevale estate.

Summary of Interest

The large bank of the cutting has small exposures of, and is covered by, talus from the Merevale Shale Formation of the Stockingford Shale Group. The adjacent disused quarry also has small areas of exposure and in the adjacent field the ploughed area next to the quarry shows considerable amounts of broken shale. This shale has in the past yielded dendroid graptolites proving the early Ordovician age.
