

**Warwickshire Geological Conservation Group (WGCG)**  
**Local Geological Site - LGS 84 Edge Hill Landslip Update, 1 May 2019**

- A hummocky land slipped feature with composite rotational slips.
- The site is best approached from the lane in the direction of Alnescote in order to park safely on the grass verge before reaching the busy B4086.
- The landslip is on private property in a field containing livestock.
- The field is surrounded by an overgrown hedge but the site can be viewed from a gateway on the lane from Alnescote or from a wide grassy verge on the B4086.
- There are no interpretation boards.
- There is no evidence of dumping, landfill, vandalism or other detrimental effects.

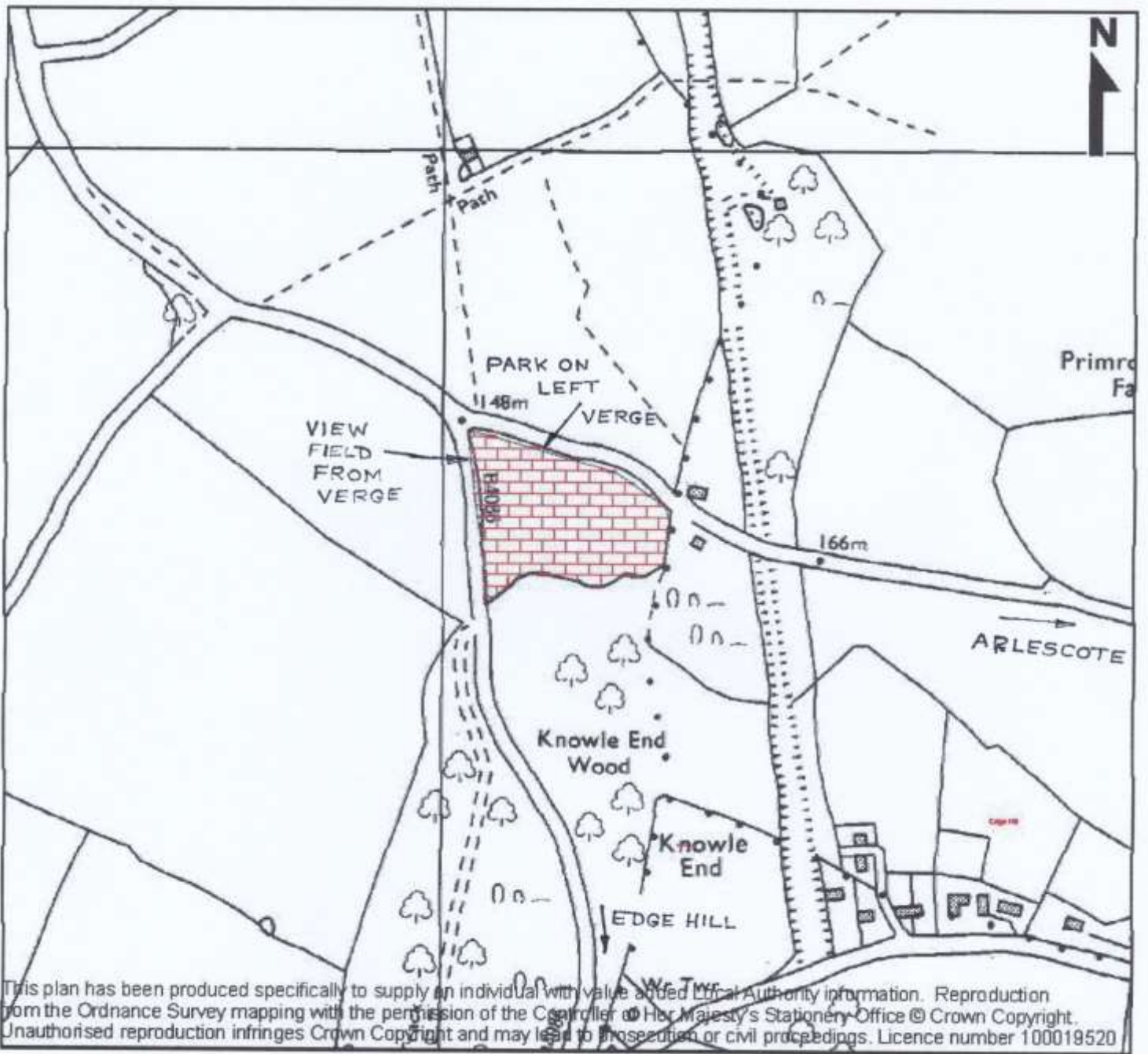
