

Warwickshire Geological Conservation Group (WGCG)

Local Geological Site - LGS 85 Warmington Church Marlestone, Update 01 May 2019

- A small natural outcrop of cambered Marlestone
- The two small exposures that protrude from the supporting wall of the church site can be approached safely on a short footpath between the wall and the road.
- However, anyone visiting the site should be aware that it is alongside a main road where vehicles travel at high speed.
- A convenient lay-by exits a few metre past the site and provides easy public access to the exposures.
- The previously reported collapse of a section of the supporting wall has now been repaired with squared blocks of Marlestone.
- There are no physical restrictions to access.
- There are no interpretation boards.
- The exposure is not obscured by vegetation.
- There is no evidence of dumping, landfill, vandalism or other detrimental effects.
- The site appears secure.
