Warwickshire Geological Conservation Group (WGCG) Local Geological Site - LGS 94 Kings Hill Nurseries, Update July 2016

Brief Description:

 A long 3m high section displaying rhythmically deposited sandstones and mudstones in the Permian Kenilworth Sandstone Formation. The Permian rocks are capped with a slope deposit of Pleistocene or Holocene age which features well defined, thin, stratified layers of clays and silty clays.

Monitoring Report:

- This site has very easy access as it is the route to the entrance of the nursery shop.
- The exposure is still obvious, but is getting to be overgrown
