

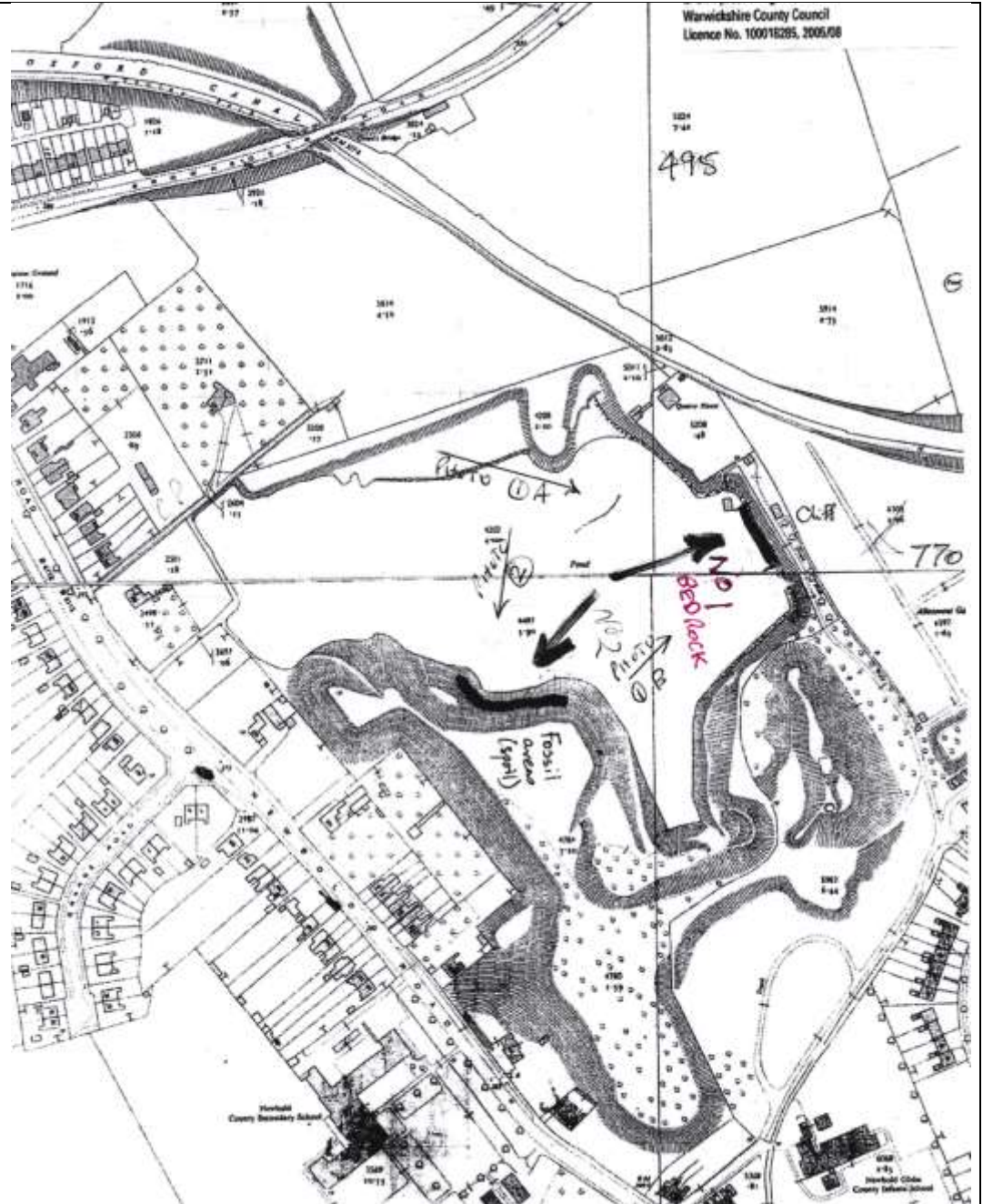
**Warwickshire Geological conservation Group (WGCG)**  
**Local Geological Site - LGS 95 Newbold Quarry, Update 20 Nov 2019**

**Brief Description:**

- An inaccessible 4m vertical section in the alternating mudstones and fine-grained limestones of the Rugby Limestone Member of the Blue Lias Fmn., together with an accessible area of spoil with frequent *Gryphaea* and crinoid ossicles.

**Monitoring Report:**

- Bedrock Feature 1 is still mostly exposed but the covered areas would be difficult to clear. The cover is from bushes hanging over the rock face.
- There is no apparent scree or soil movement.
- The quarry is already flooded and at a constant level.
- There is no dumping or landfill.
- There is no quarrying or engineering works.
- There is no development (Housing or Industrial)
- Bedrock Feature 2 (Spoil Fossil Area) is mostly exposed but the unexposed areas are capable of being cleared.
- There is no apparent scree or soil movement.
- There is no dumping or landfill.
- There is no quarrying or engineering works.
- There is no development (Housing or Industrial)
- Overall the site is on a desirable condition for the use of the features identified.
- Feature 2 could be fairly readily exposed if required adjacent to the path by scrub removal.
- The status of the site is still good.
