

**Warwickshire Geological Conservation Group (WGCG)**  
**Local Geological Site - LGS 99 Bell Green Cutting, Update October 2016**

**Brief Description:**

- The site is a 21 metres long exposure of the Triassic Bromsgrove Sandstone Formation (Sherwood Sandstone Group).
- The height 5-6 metres at the SW end falling to 1-2 metres at the NE end.
- At the SW end the lower 3 metres is exposed with the part above heavily covered in ivy and other vegetation.
- At the NE end the exposure is reduced to about 1 metre.

**Monitoring Report:**

- The site is on Bell Green Road, a very busy highway.
- Parking is possible some distance West along Old Church Road as well as Clark Street.
- The exposure is clear. However, there is netting on the NE end which is just collecting rubbish.
- The exposure did not seem to be 21 m in length.
- Another portion is exposed on the opposite SE side of the road.
